Eligibility Requirements:

Scholarships are awarded based on academic excellence, leadership skills and a commitment to equine veterinary medicine.

- ✓ Currently enrolled and in good standing at an AVMA-accredited school of veterinary medicine in the United States, Canada, or West Indies
- ✓ On track to graduate with your DVM or equivalent in 2025 or 2026
- ✓ National AAEP Student Member (paid through August 31, 2024) and active within their school's AAEP chapter

Application Components:

A single online application based on graduation year

Eligible students will need to submit the following:

- ✓ Current Transcript (official transcript not required, but must include all courses to date)
- ✓ Resume or Curriculum vitae
- ✓ Essays for 2025 graduates
