Prepare

- Gather your documents for upload:
- Letter of Intent
 - Scientific Abstract
 - Curriculum Vitae



Apply

The Foundation uses **Cadmium** to collect and review **online grant applications**.

- ✓ Create an account & complete the **Account Profile**. If you are also applying for a research grant, you will only need to create one account.

- ✓ **Start a New Application -**

Enter the applicant researcher's LAST NAME, FIRST NAME (in ALL CAPS) as the grant submission title.

Choose the **Proposal Category** based on the grant or award you are eligible & applying for.

- ✓ Complete the **Task List**.

All tasks must be completed before you can **Save Submission** and proceed to the Summary Review. You can save and return to the application at any time.



1. Letter of Intent

One-page letter outlining your long-term equine research intent, as well as how this will impact equine veterinary medicine and positively affect horse health. Please include in your letter how our \$5,000 award will help you do this.



2. Scientific Abstract

3. Curriculum Vitae



4. Academic Mentor/Evaluator

Here you invite your mentor to contribute to your application via an emailed link.



5. Mentor/Evaluator Recommendation
