
Thank you for supporting equine nonprofits. As a component of their application, each organization/facility is required to have support from an AAEP Member veterinarian.

### Step Two: Recommendations

The recommendation is broken into two tasks for references: 1. profile and 2. reference



#### 1. Complete your AAEP Member Veterinary Reference Profile

From your email invitation, **Log in** and update your profile information, including basic contact information, professional information. Reference individuals only need to complete one profile, regardless of how many recommendations they are submitting.



#### 2. Reference Only Presentation task

This task includes 5 questions relating to your veterinary work with the organization/facility as well as a space for you to provide additional comments for your recommendation.

**Applying organizations/facilities** are responsible for insuring all tasks are complete, including the veterinary reference, before submitting their application.

Applicants can monitor an invited reference's progress and send reminders by resending the invitation. Applicants only see that a reference has completed their tasks, not the actual entry.
