

SCHOLARSHIP INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS

Prepare

- ✓ Gather your current transcript (official transcript not required, but must include all courses to date) and resume or curriculum vitae, and list of externships.
- ✓ Notify your references that you are applying and provide them with the **Instructions for Scholarship References** document. Note: The Coyote Rock Ranch scholarship also requires a personal reference.

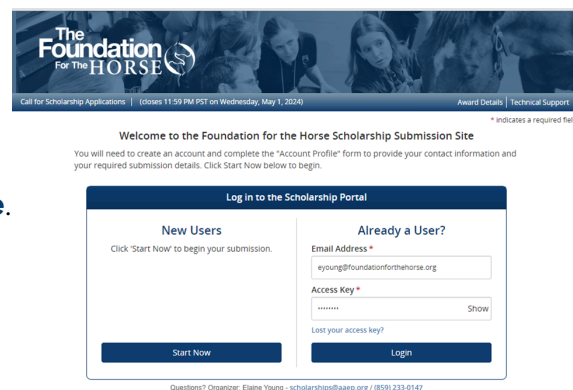
Apply

The Foundation uses **Cadmiun** to collect and review a **single online application** for all eligible scholarships based on graduation year.

- ✓ Create an account & complete the **Account Profile**.

- ✓ **Start a New Application -**

Enter your **LAST NAME, FIRST NAME** in the **Applicant Name** field. Choose the **Scholarship Type** based on your graduation year.

- ✓ Complete the **Task List**.

All tasks must be completed before you can **Save Application**.

2. Upload - Resume, Transcript, Externships

- **Resume or Curriculum Vitae** - Include your equine and veterinary experience, along with community and scholastic leadership experience. Document should not to exceed two pages. Preferred file is PDF or Word format.
- **Transcript** - Official transcripts are not required; however, your transcript must be current and easily readable. Preferred file is PDF format, screen shots will not be accepted.
- **List of Externships** - Include completed and future scheduled externships. List the Practice, dates, and if completed the areas of practice you observed/participated in. Preferred file is PDF or Word format.



Tasks can be completed in any order - except for **Task 4: Reference Contacts** which must be completed before **Task 5: Recommendation**. Invite your references (task 4) **EARLY**, so they have ample time to complete their portion of the recommendation.

After you click "invite" your reference, they will receive an email from **noreply@goCadmium.com** with a direct link to create a profile and complete their recommendation for your application. **Remind them to check junk & spam folders.**



5. Recommendation This task is for your invited references.

Applicants are responsible for monitoring the completion of their references. Content of the recommendation is NOT visible to applicants. A  indicates a complete recommendation.



You can monitor your references progress and send reminders by clicking the invite button. Once all are complete, you MUST click the "complete task" button.

References are asked to evaluate the following skills:

- Horse Handling
- Critical / Clinical reasoning
- Teamwork / Collaboration
- Dependability / Honesty
- Client Communication
- Leadership
- Self-reliance / Work Independently
- Common sense
